Yeshivas Gevuras Ari Celebrates First Siyum

Yeshivas Gevuras Ari, a division of Mercaz Torah U'Tefillah led by Rabbi Moshe Yaakov Edelman as Rosh Yeshiva and under the guidance of the Zidichover Rebbe Shlit"א, celebrated its very first Siyum on Maseches Brachos.

This unique Yeshiva geared towards non-working men, launched right after Chanukah of last year. The Yeshiva maintains a learning pace of an Amud per day, and they got very close to the end of Maseches Brachos at the end of the summer Zman. A decision was made to begin Maseches Shabbos in the beginning of Elul Zman, but many of the participants wanted to complete Brachos so they spent their days throughout Bein Hazmanim continuing to learn together to finish the entire Masechta. For many of the participants, this was the first Siyum they have made in their lifetime!

The Siyum was graced by the participation of Harav Aharon Feldman Shlit"א, Rosh Yeshiva of Ner Yisroel, who's Chizuk and support were the catalyst for the

launch of the Yeshiva. Harav Feldman, clearly moved by this Siyum, addressed the crowd and stated he expects this Yeshiva will be imitated throughout the country.

The Siyum was also graced by the presence of the Zidichov Rebbe Shlit"א, who address the crowd and said in jest that he thinks this Yeshiva is the cause of the Mashiach not coming as their learning is giving Hashem more Nachas than the Avodah of the Korbanos in the Beis HaMikdash...

A few of the participants in the Yeshiva shared their feelings towards the end of the event. Among them, Mr. Jack Jacob shared how he learned that a person can be B'simcha when he's with Hashem, and that with every word of Torah he's learning he feels Hashem is speaking to him and that is his source of Simcha. Mr. Jacob blew away the crowd showcasing his binder with over 1000 pages of notes he's taken since the start of the Yeshiva. What a tremendous Kiddush Hashem!
